Peace Flag Workshop



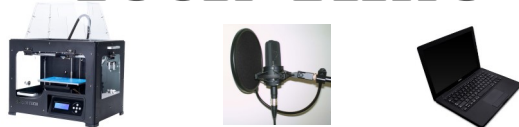
